## Notes from March 9th, 2021 Lectio Divina - Faith Sharing Zoom Gathering

Thank you for coming to discuss and reflect on the Word of God last night Tuesday March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Below is an overview of what we did.

In summary we started by going over the homework, rereading Mark 1 and found various names that Jesus was called, such as *Son of Man*, *Son of God*, *My dear Son*, etc. We read and reflected on the Gospels of Sunday March 7th and this coming Sunday the 14th. The 7th was John 2:13-25 about Jesus Clearing the Temple Courts. Sunday the 14th's Gospel will be John 3:14-21, Jesus and Nicodemus with theme of Light and Darkness.

We learned the following about the book of Mark:

"Traditionally, the gospel is said to have been written shortly before A.D. 70 in Rome, at a time of impending persecution and when destruction loomed over Jerusalem. Its audience seems to have been Gentiles, unfamiliar with Jewish customs (Mark 7:3–4, 11). The book aimed to equip such Christians to stand faithful in the face of persecution (Markk 13:9–13), while going on with the proclamation of the gospel begun in Galilee (Mark13:10; 14:9). Modern research often proposes as the author an unknown Hellenistic Jewish Christian, possibly in Syria, and perhaps shortly after the year 70."

## The outline of the Gospel according to Mark is the following:

- I. The Preparation for the Public Ministry of Jesus (1:1–13)
- II. The Mystery of Jesus (1:14–8:26)
- III. The Mystery Begins to Be Revealed (8:27–9:32)
- IV. The Full Revelation of the Mystery (9:33–16:8)
